

### This Thursday: "Getting to Got it" Parenting Workshop by Dr. Betty Garner

Have you ever wondered why some kids don't "get it" even after you have explained something over and over? Or wondered why they sometimes refuse to do their work or struggle to complete assignments?

Help your children develop the basic mental tools they need to make sense of information on their own by attending Dr. Betty Garner's presentation on Thursday. February 17.



During her presentation, Dr. Garner, a Montessori parent, educator and educational researcher, will draw upon her experiences as an art teacher during which she watched intelligent, creative children decide that they didn't "get what it took" to be successful in school.

In the introduction to her book "Getting to Got it: Helping Struggling Students Learn How to Learn," Dr. Garner writes, "The students taught me to see learning in a new way." As she explored the development of children's cognitive structures, she also developed a philosophy of the "spiritual dimensions of learning."
